Recycling Information

Owners and Guests: it is very important that we follow the recycling rules. The City of Naples has suggested that we might lose our pick-up if we continue to add unacceptable items. The blue recycling bins are located behind the fence behind the office. Recycle is picked up early each Monday morning. If you bring your recycles in a plastic bag, please dump your materials, and take the bag home.

There should be NO plastic bags in recycling.

All containers should be rinsed and free of debris.

No peanuts, Styrofoam, take-out, meat, or egg trays

Acceptable Recyclable Materials:

Glass: soda, beer, liquor and beer bottles; glass jars and any other clear, brown, or green glass bottles

Aluminum: soda and beer cans, pie pans, food cans including soup, fruit, juice, vegetable, pet food and tuna cans

Plastic: Plastic containers marked No. 1-7 including water bottles, milk jugs, detergent and bleach bottles, soda bottles, shampoo bottles, butter or spread tubs.

Paper: newspaper, magazines, paperback and hardcover books, brown, white and colored bags, phone books, junk mail, catalogs, office and computer paper, corrugated cardboard boxes (all should be flattened), cardboard-cereal, cracker, pasta, shoe, gift and clean pizza boxes.

Unacceptable Recyclable Materials:

Glass: medicine bottles, dishes, drinking glasses, windows, mirrors, cookware like Pyrex or Corning

Aluminum: pots and pans, cooking utensils, screen doors and windows, lawn furniture, used foil

Plastic: plastic bags or wrappers, motor oil, household chemical containers, flowerpots, hoses, toys, Styrofoam

Paper: no paper products with wax coating (milk, juice or ice cream cartons), used paper coffee or beverage cups, paper towels, toilet paper and napkins

Electronics: The City of Naples does not offer collection of electronic items. These items should be dropped off at the Naples Recycling Drop-Off Center at 2640 Corporate Flight Drive (west of Airport Road, north of the Naples Airport) Tuesday-Saturday 8:30-4:30. 239-643-3099
